Teachers Checklist

1. Check dates available at the site (call 01224 581313 / core@core94.com), we cannot hold a date until we have received an email confirmation from the school confirming the date.
2. Establish final number of participants taking part in the event and inform us of any changes to your original booking at least one week prior to the event.
3. Download the Frequently Asked Questions and the Parental Consent Form from our website and send out to each parent/player. No player should play paintball without a signed Consent Form. The consent form and FAQ's gives guardians/players an overview of paintball and allows them to give an informed consent.
4. Collect together all the consent forms for your group. This should give you final numbers for the day. Ensure that you keep these forms on file as you will need to bring them on the day.
5. Advise players that they will need to bring a pack lunch and any money for tuck shop and extra paint they may wish to purchase on the day. Additional paint will be available at the following rates. 100 paintballs for £5 or 500 paintballs for £15. It is also worth advising the children to take gloves.
6. Make sure that you have received our booking confirmation this will give you all the details you require to organise the day. Including directions to the site, start time, number of players booked, and the contact number of the site manager.
7. Finalise your transport arrangements including departure and collection times to ensure your group arrive at the meeting point at the correct time. Advise us of these times at least one week prior to the event.
8. Remember to take along the signed parental consent forms for all players. As players cannot take part without this.
